Pronunciation

SCH = /ʃ/ - die Schnecke - snail	IE = /i:/ - der Brief - letter	EI = /ai/ - der Eimer - bucket
V = /f/ - der Vater - father	V = /w/ - die vase - vase	-
S = /s/ - die Sonne - the sun	S = /ʃ/ - der Sport - the sport	-
CH = /k/ - der Chor - the choir	CH = /x/ - das Buch - the book	CH = /ch/ - der Elch - the elk

- for some words, we pronounce "v" like we pronounce the letter "w", as you can hear on the next screen. This is usually the case with foreign words.
- In other cases, the pronunciation of a certain letter depends on either the letters preceding or following it. You will find some examples for that on the next screens.
